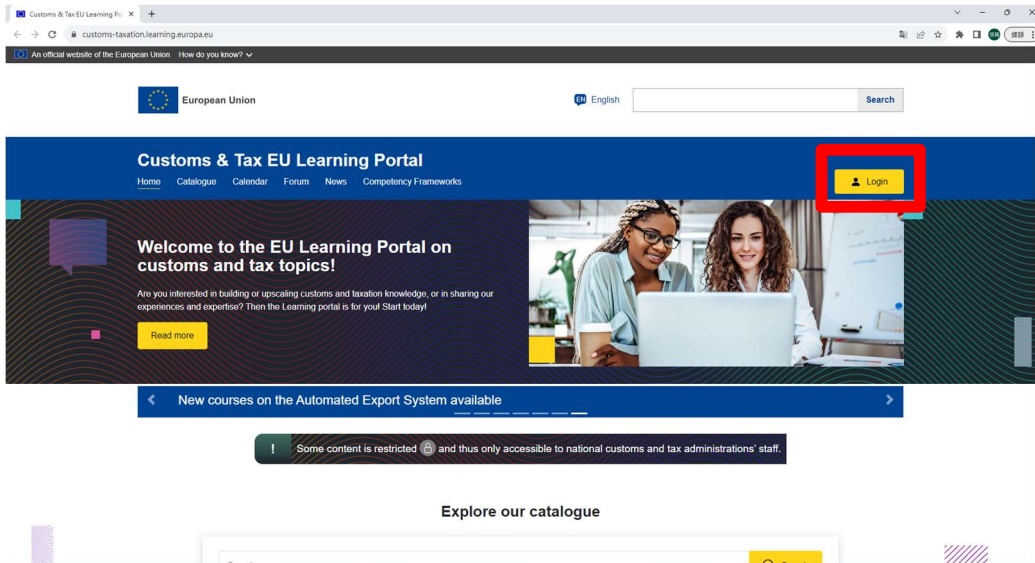

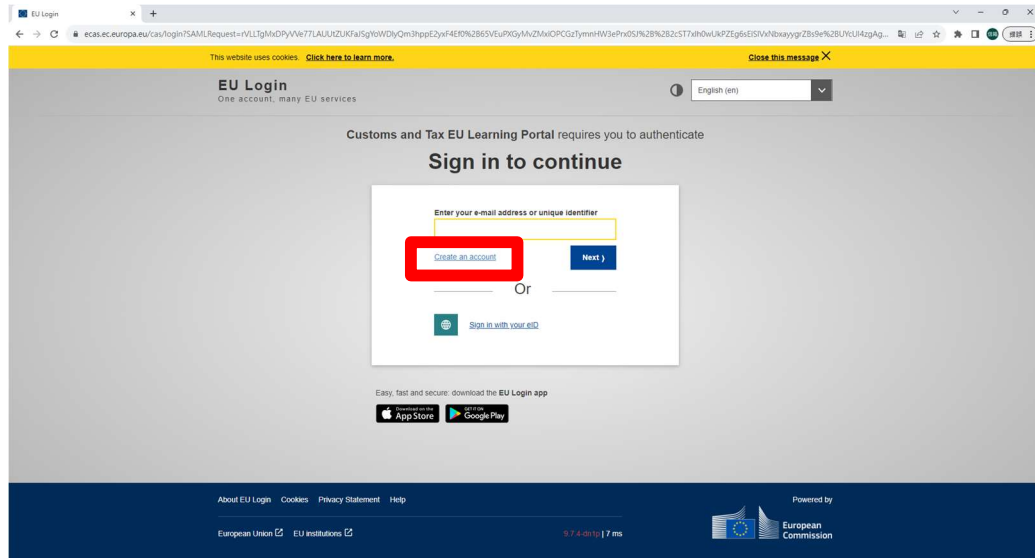

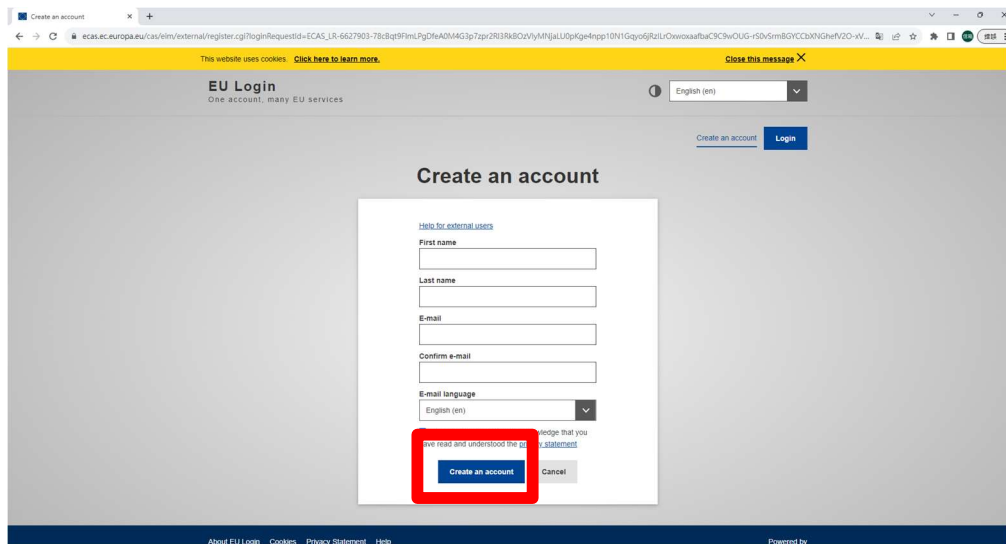

2. 點擊 Login



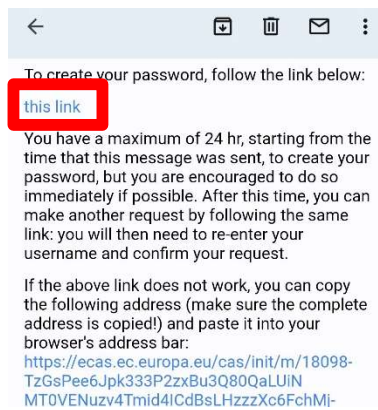
## 3. 點擊 Create an account 創建帳號

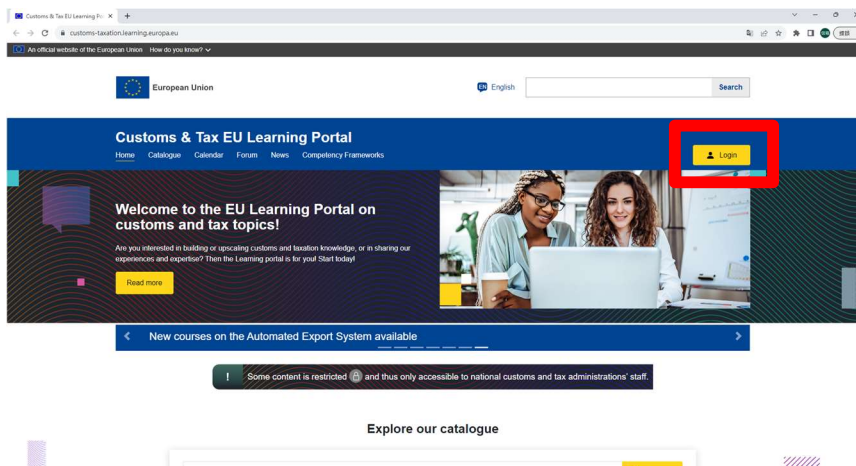

#### 1.1 Introduction
